Old Business:

Brand Guide 2.0

The Committee added a few items, like guiding principles (consistency, clarity, and credibility). It would be beneficial to have examples of approved and non-approved logos/graphics.

A subgroup will be created to start working on designs and rough drafts of branding systems.

New Business:

Tiger Bedazzle for Website

If you click on the logos, they take you to a page with information about the significance of the celebration/recognition for that month.

The committee discussed having the RCC website logo phase in and out between the original logo and the custom logo.

Home Page Carousel

The website was created for new students, so the carousel replacing the Hero video may not be consistent with the original purpose of the website. The carousel could be useful on the student Portal.

Staff Directory

A mock-up of the digital staff directory was reviewed by the Committee with positive feedback.
